1. Eligibility Criteria:

Contractors who fulfil the following requirements shall be eligible to apply.

- a. Bidder should have valid GST registration.
- b. Bidder should have valid KPWD A class or equivalent registration in central/state Govt. departments
- c. Bidder should have satisfactorily completed the below mentioned works as Principal Contractor during last **seven** years.
 - i. Construction, testing and commissioning of Three Numbers of ETP/CETPs with capacity 0.25 MLD or above

or

ii. Construction, testing and commissioning of Two Numbers of ETP/CETPs with capacity 0.4 MLD or above

or

- iii. Construction, testing and commissioning of One Number of ETP/CETPs with capacity 0.5 MLD or above
- d. The Contractor should either have an in-house capacity or may engage reputed firms/professionals who have executed design and engineering of at least one effluent treatment plant of capacity not less than 0.5 MLD (Client Certificate to be enclosed)



- e. Should have an average annual financial turnover of Rs 4.80 Crores of any three financial years out of last five years ending 31st March 2023 (2017-18,2019-20,2020-21,2021-22,2022-23) (Balance sheet and profit & loss account certified by Chartered Accountant to be uploaded).
- f. Should not have incurred any loss in more than two years during the last five financial years ending 31st March, 2023 (balance sheet and profit and loss account certified by Chartered accountant to be uploaded).
- 2. The intending bidder must read the terms and conditions of KINFRA-6 carefully. He should only submit his bid if he considers himself eligible and he is in possession of all the documents required.
- **3.** Information and Instructions for bidders posted on website shall form part of bid document.
- 4. The tender document(s), may be downloaded free of cost from the e-Government Procurement (e-GP) website (www.etenders.kerala.gov.in). No payment is required for downloading the tender documents from the above website however a bid submission fee, as mentioned below in this document, is required to be remitted through online payment mechanism for e-procurement system of Govt. of Kerala.Only those bidders having a valid and active registration, on the date of bid submission, shall submit bids online on the e-GP website.
- 5. All bids shall be submitted online on the e-GP website only in the relevant envelope(s)/cover(s), as per the type of tender. No manual submission of bids shall be entertained for the tenders published through e-GP system under anycircumstances. However signed copies of documentary evidences as the proof of eligibility criteria shall be submitted to KINFRA in hard copies also.
- **6.** The e-GP system shall not allow submission of bids online after the stipulated date & time. The bidder is advised to submit the bids well before the stipulated date & time to avoid any kind of network issues, traffic congestion, etc. In this regard, KINFRA shall not be responsible for any kind of such issues faced by bidder.
- 7. Ineligible bidders or bidders who do not possess valid & active registration, on the date of bid submission, are strictly advised to refrain themselves from participating inthis tender. If such instances are noticed, the same shall be treated as "fake bidding" by the respective bidder and such bidder shall be blacklisted as per KINFRA rules in force. The bidders, who submit their bids for this tender after digitally signing using their Digital Signature Certificate (DSC), accept that they have clearly understood and agreed the terms and conditions including the Form/ Annexures of this tender. Mention of price details at any place other than the designated place, shall disqualify the bid and the bid shall be summarily rejected.
- **8.** Tender duly signed using bidder's valid Digital Signature Certificate shall be submitted online on e-GP website www.etenders.kerala.gov.in
- **9.** General Conditions of Contract (KINFRA 7/8) shall be available in downloadable manner from www.kinfra.org and shall form part of bid document.
- **10.** The technical bid shall be opened first on due date and time as mentioned above.
- 11. The time and date of opening of Price Bid of the tender shall be intimated only to the



qualified and technically acceptable bidders at a later date.

GUIDELINES FOR E-PROCUREMENT

Prospective bidders willing to participate in this tender shall necessarily register themselves with e-procurement portal (www.etenders.kerala.gov.in). The tender timeline is available in the critical date section of this tender published in www.etenders.kerala.gov.in.

A). Online Bidder registration process:

Bidders should have a Class II or above Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) to be procured from any Registration Authorities (RA) under the Certifying Agency of India. Details of RAs will be available on www.cca.gov.in. Once, the DSC is obtained, bidders have to register on www.etenders.kerala.gov.in website for participating in this tender. Website registration is a one-time process without any registration fees. However, bidders have to procure DSC at their own cost.

B). Online Tender Process:

The tender process shall consist of the following stages:

- Downloading of tender document: Tender document will be available for free download on <u>www.etenders.kerala.gov.in</u>. However, tender document fees shall be payable at the time of bid submission as stipulated in this tender document.
- ii. Pre-bid meeting: As per NIT
- iii. **Publishing of Corrigendum:** All corrigenda shall be published on www.etenders.kerala.gov.in and shall not be available elsewhere.
- iv. **Bid submission**: Bidders have to submit their bids along with supporting documents to support their eligibility, as required in this tender document on www.etenders.kerala.gov.in.
- v. **Opening of Technical Bid and Financial Bid:** The technical bid will be opened at same time mentioned in Information & instruction to the bidders.
- vi. Time of opening of financial bids of pre-qualified bidders will be intimate later.

C). Tender Document Fees and Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)

The Bidder shall pay, a tender document fees and Earnest Money Deposit. The Bid security is required to protect the purchaser against risk of Bidder's conduct, which would warrant the forfeiture of security.

Online Payment modes:

All online payments specified in the tender document shall be made through Multi Option Payment System as per the requirement.



D). SUBMISSION PROCESS:

For submission of bids, all interested bidders have to register online as explained above in this document. After registration, bidders shall submit their Technical bid and Financial bid online on www.etenders.kerala.gov.in along with online payment of tenderdocument fees and EMD.

It is necessary to click on "Freeze bid" link/ icon to complete the process of bid submission otherwise the bid will not get submitted online and the same shall not be available for viewing/ opening during bid opening process.
